

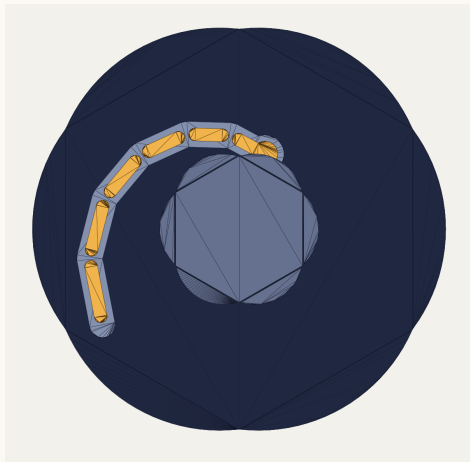
POCKET REVEAL • 3 PRINTED PARTS

MIDNIGHT ORBIT BLOOM

Turn the outer petals.
Find the comet.
Turn back to night.

FIRST MOVE

Keep the center bud still. Turn only the outer rosette clockwise to its stop.



OUTER PETALS TURN

CLOCKWISE ∪ ABOUT 60°

CENTER BUD STAYS LOCKED

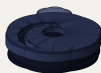
ONE MOTION. TWO SKIES.

MIDNIGHT ORBIT BLOOM

Look at the flower face whenever a direction is named.

1 FIND THE PARTS

Three printed parts — exploded



TOP C locking bud
MIDDLE B outer rosette
BOTTOM A fixed base
1 each • no loose hardware

2 LOCK THE CENTER

If assembled, go to step 3.

Place B over A. Turn gently until its hidden lug drops into the channel; bring B to the closed stop.

Align C's lugs with the slots. Lower to seat; turn C clockwise $\frac{1}{4}$ turn to lock.

CHECK: B TURNS; C STAYS FIXED.

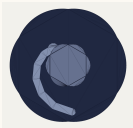
3 MAKE THE REVEAL

- 1 HOLD A by its fixed lower petals.
- 2 TURN B clockwise to its stop (about 60°). **COMET APPEARS.**
- 3 TURN B counterclockwise to its stop. **COMET HIDES.**

KEEP C STILL.

RESET

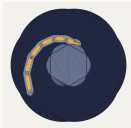
CLOSED 0°



COUNTERCLOCKWISE ↺

REVEAL

OPEN 60°



↻ **CLOCKWISE**

SERVICE ONLY

Close B. Turn C counterclockwise $\frac{1}{4}$ turn; lift C, then B. Brush clean. Reassemble at step 2. Never carry or use without C locked.

IF IT STICKS

Do not force. Clear debris; reassemble. If C turns, lifts, or will not lock:

STOP USE.

PACK + CARE

Closed • locked • dry • flat

SAFETY

Removable small part during service: keep from children who mouth objects. Stop use if cracked, sharp, or damaged.
