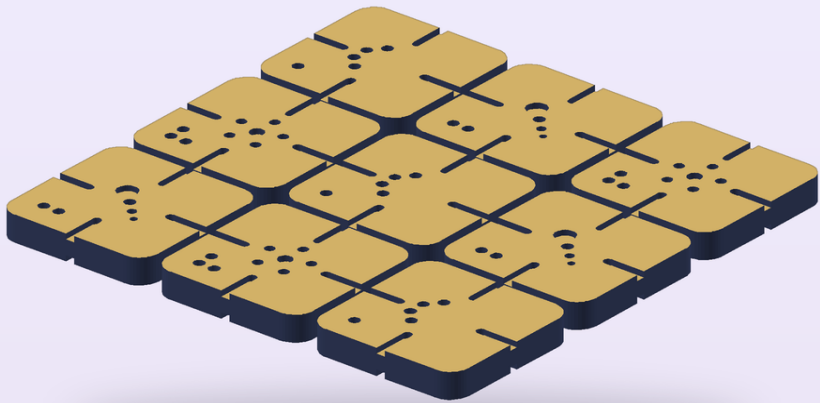


● POCKET CONSTELLATION TOY

NIGHT-SKY WEAVE

TURN • FLIP • WEAVE



**Nine reversible tiles. One shared edge gate. No
fixed answer.**

IN THE BOX • 3 CRESCENT • 3 COMET • 3 STAR

Three families. Nine ways to begin.

Both faces can play. Family identity survives without color: feel the center dots, then count the tiny corner pips.



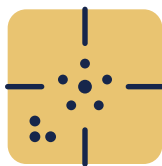
CRESCENT × 3

Four dots curve like a moon. One corner pip.



COMET × 3

Four dots trail from large to small. Two corner pips.



STAR × 3

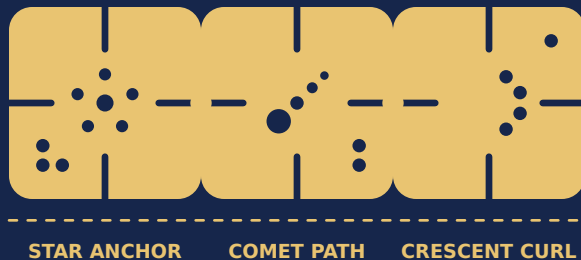
A center dot with five orbiting dots. Three corner pips.

SET UP ON A FLAT SURFACE

- 1 Place any tile face up.
- 2 Add a neighbor edge-to-edge so the centered grooves meet.
- 3 Rotate or flip until the line feels ready to continue.

Your first weave

Connections are loose on purpose: nudge edges together; never press, bend, or force a lock.



1

Choose an anchor

Start with a Star. Pick any edge gate as your first direction.

2

Carry the path

Turn a Comet beside it. Let the centered grooves touch edge-to-edge.

3

Give it a character

Curl a Crescent at the end. What did the three tiles become? Name it.

THREE OPEN CHALLENGES

SNOWFLAKE

Build around a center.

DRAGON

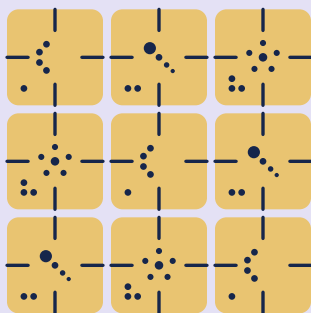
Make a stepped spine.

CROWN

Find a base and peaks.

Reset the sky. Keep every star.

PACK-AWAY MOSAIC



Count 3 across × 3 down = all 9.

IF THE WEAVE FEELS STUCK

LINE STOPS?

Rotate a quarter-turn or flip the tile.

TILES DRIFT?

Use a flat surface and nudge edges together.

FAMILY UNCLEAR?

Count corner pips: 1 Crescent, 2 Comet, 3 Star.

RESET IN THREE MOVES

- 1 Gather and count all nine.
- 2 Make three rows of three.
- 3 Place the mosaic flat; either face may be up.

CARE & SAFETY

- Wipe with a lightly damp cloth, then dry before storing. Do not soak.
- Keep away from high heat and open flame.
- Small parts: keep away from children under 3 and anyone who mouths objects.
- Before play, count all nine and inspect them. Set aside any cracked piece or sharp edge.
- If a piece is missing, stop and find it before packing away.
